

1. Local Authority Self Assessment of Progress Towards Targets

The Kelly Survey asked Local Authorities to make a self-assessment from the following choices:

A - We are clear on our plans for meeting our LATS obligations. The majority of new infrastructure is in place, being built, or we are not anticipating any difficulties putting it in place in time, and overall we are confident the infrastructure is either in place or will be built to meet 2013 targets.

B - We are clear on our plans for meeting our LATS obligations, however we are still in the early stages of procurement and there are some variables which may stop us from meeting our 2010 targets / our 2013 targets (local targets).

C - We have not yet decided on the exact type of process we want to use for diverting the biodegradable element of residual waste away from landfill.
